# What is the Coordination Program?

Funded by Lilly Endowment Inc., and administered by the Center for Congregations, to do the following:

- To keep the purpose and goals of this initiative in front of the grantee organizations, particularly project directors, denominational and judicatory leadership, and others who are in positions of influence.
- To encourage communities of learning and practice within specific grantee organizations that enable them to design, implement, and continually assess and sustain programmatic initiatives that promise to achieve their identified aims.

- To gather and disseminate learning about the collective enterprise to grantee organizations, to other denominations and religious bodies, and to the public
- To work with staff of Lilly Endowment and assist them in overall responsibilities in support of this initiative.

- To nurture an initiative-wide learning community that will encourage grantee organizations to: (a) learn from one another; (b) engage collaboratively in program design and implementation; and (c) learn from their own work, paying attention to program outcomes and impact.
- To provide coaching advice, support, and resources to specific projects, as needed, in order to help grantees make connections to people and resources, and improve the quality of their work.
