CFLI offers **Jump Start**, a personal finance retreat for ministerial couples or singles. This interactive retreat takes a formational, devotional, and practical look at personal finances and identifies tools to help build spending plans.

### PERSONAL FINANCIAL COACHING:

Pastors, missionaries, or chaplains who have participated in a Jump Start retreat can receive up to four free personal finance coaching sessions from qualified and trained coaches.



# MINISTRY EXCELLENCE FUND



As part of the Covenant Financial Leadership Initiative, pastors are invited to submit requests to the Ministry Excellence Fund (MEF). This fund provides aid to help alleviate some types of financial distress for ministers. The two main areas for help are in instances of catastrophes and for consumer aid.

**CONSUMER AID GRANT:** Ministers may apply for a grant for up to \$10,000 to address consumer debt or student loans. Ministers who receive this grant commit to meeting with a financial coach that may continue up to nine months at no expense to you. To participate, contact Develop Leaders at financialleadership@covchurch.org.

**CATASTROPHE AID:** Ministers who experience a once-in-a-lifetime event of loss may be eligible for aid beyond what the Ministers' Care and Crisis Fund provides. This is a match fund. Participation by the minister's local church and regional conference is expected. To participate, contact Develop Leaders at ministry@covchurch.org.
